





### **BEFORE CLEANING**

- Vacuum area thoroughly.
- 2 For the best results, pretreat spots, stains or heavily soiled areas by spraying with a pretreat or spot & stain remover.

### PREPARING THE MACHINE

 Pull top tank handle up and lift to remove dirty water tank.




2 Remove bottom clean water tank and fill with hot tap water to the WATER line.

- 3 Measure BISSELL full size machine formula using cap on tank. Fill cap to line twice for each full tank of water.
- Screw cap back on and set tank back on base of machine.
- Replace dirty water tank on top and push handle back to lock into place.

#### **CARPET CLEANING**

- Plug into a proper outlet and turn power switch to ON (1).
- 2 Release handle by pushing lower green handle release while pulling handle back.
- 3 While pressing the red spray trigger, make one slow forward wet cleaning pass and another back.



A Release the red trigger and go over area again with a slow forward and back pass to remove dirty water and aid in drying.



- 6 Repeat wet cleaning passes (with trigger pressed) as needed until water being pulled up appears clean.
- 6 Continue drying passes (without trigger pressed) until you can't see any more water being pulled up.

Note: While cleaning, watch the flow indicator, if it stops spinning, check the water tanks.

# **UPHOLSTERY & STAIR CLEANING**

- Vacuum area thoroughly.
- 2 Test a small hidden area for colorfastness. If color is affected do not use. Clean upholstery only if there is a W or WS on the manufacturer's
- 3 Prepare the machine by filling tank and formula

4 To attach the accessory hose, first insert the small solution hose into the open

hole above the tank and turn clockwise to lock. Attach the larger hose to the top tank by lifting the green cap, inserting and turning clockwise until locked into place.

5 Clean by pressing the red trigger to spray cleaning solution onto the area to be cleaned, then slowly move the tool back and forth to remove dirty water.

### **EMPTYING THE MACHINE**

Remove the dirty water tank by pulling the top handle up and lifting away from the machine.



2 Remove the top of the dirty water tank by pulling the handle all the

way forward to unlock, then lift tank to remove.

3 Pour dirty water out.

## PREPARING MACHINE TO **RETURN TO THE STORE**

To avoid cleaning fee, follow these steps:

- Unplug the machine.
- 2 Remove and empty the dirty and clean water tanks. Rinse and let dry.
- 3 Wipe down the bottom of the machine to remove any hair or debris.
- A Rinse the accessory hose and tool (if rented
- Put tanks back onto machine and return machine and hose/tools to the store.

### **GROUNDING INSTRUCTIONS**

This appliance must be connected to a grounded wiring system. The cord for this appliance has an equipment-grounding conductor and a grounding plug. It must only be plugged into an outlet that is properly installed and grounded in accordance with all local codes and ordinances.



# **⚠ WARNING:**

a qualified electrician or service person if you aren't sure if the outlet is properly grounded. DO NOT MODIFY THE PLUG. If it will not fit the outlet, have a proper outlet installed by a qualified electrician. This appliance is designed for use on a nominal 120-volt circuit, and has a grounding attachment plug that looks like the plug in the drawing above. Make certain that the appliance is connected to an outlet having the same configuration as the plug. No plug adapter should be used with this appliance.
